
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

Answer: Take the first letter of each word and place it at the end. It will spell the same word backwards.


4.What makes this number unique -- 8,549,176,320?

5.Put a coin into an empty bottle and insert a cork into the neck. How can you remove the coin without removing the cork or breaking the bottle?


Answer: Push the cork down into the bottle. Then shake the coin out.
